

Terms and Conditions of Wildlife Camera Hire

- The loan period is two weeks. Return the camera on the allocated day so that it can be loaned to another person on the waiting list.
- The camera must be returned in the same condition as it was loaned. The data card must be erased and replaced into the camera.
- To arrange pick up and returns contact Alice McGlashan. She will give you her contact details when you pick up the camera.
- Do not use the camera in public places where it could be stolen or tampered with. Be mindful other peoples' privacy when using this device.

Occupational Health and Safety

- This camera is only to be used safely at ground level by adults. It is only to be used for its intended purpose as outlined in the instructions.
- The equipment is not to be misused and is to be returned clean and in working order.
- You must not repair or modify the equipment.
- Subject to law, the use of the equipment is at your own risk. You indemnify
 the Small Farms Network Capital Region Inc. for any costs, damages or claims
 arising from your use of the equipment in breach of these terms and
 conditions.
- Should you choose to share images or video on social media, you agree to do so at your own risk.

Hire fees

- A security deposit of \$50 cash is payable by you when you pick up the camera. This deposit will be returned once the camera is returned and checked.
- The camera loan fee is \$30.
- The camera loan period is two weeks. If no one else has hired the camera the loan period can be extended at an additional cost of \$30 for 2 weeks hire.
- If you do not return the camera for any reason you may be required to pay for a replacement camera.

Records
